Graduation Report
October 2009**

Introduction

The MIIR (Management Information & Institutional Research) office in the Department of Computer Services has realized the importance of compiling a graduation statistics document as part of the graduation information.

A total of 691 awards were offered to 619 graduates who met the requirements of graduation in October 2009. The graduates were awarded with degrees, diplomas or certificates.

This document therefore, contains the relevant award statistical information, in terms award types, faculties and departments. Comparisons between faculty schools, department and gender are presented.

The data was collected from the faculty officers and forwarded to the MIIR office via emails.

The information was analysed and presented in understandable charts and tables.

Table 6 above shows the duration average duration of study in years per qualification per faculty divided in gender denominations. ***The average time to complete each qualification is calculated by using the total number of years each student is registered with the institution. The student may have been registered for and/or completed another award during this time.*** The total average duration was 5.3 years. The maximum average duration of 9.0 years is recorded under Bachelor degree by females in the faculty of engineering, while the minimum average of 3.9 years was also recorded by male graduates in the faculty of Information technology.

Figure 1: Graduates marital status

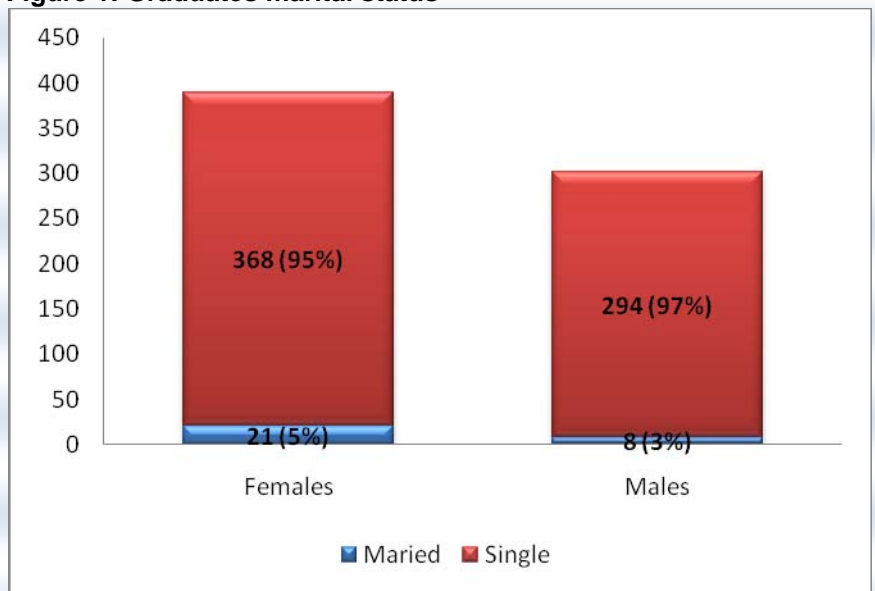

Figure 2: Age of graduates

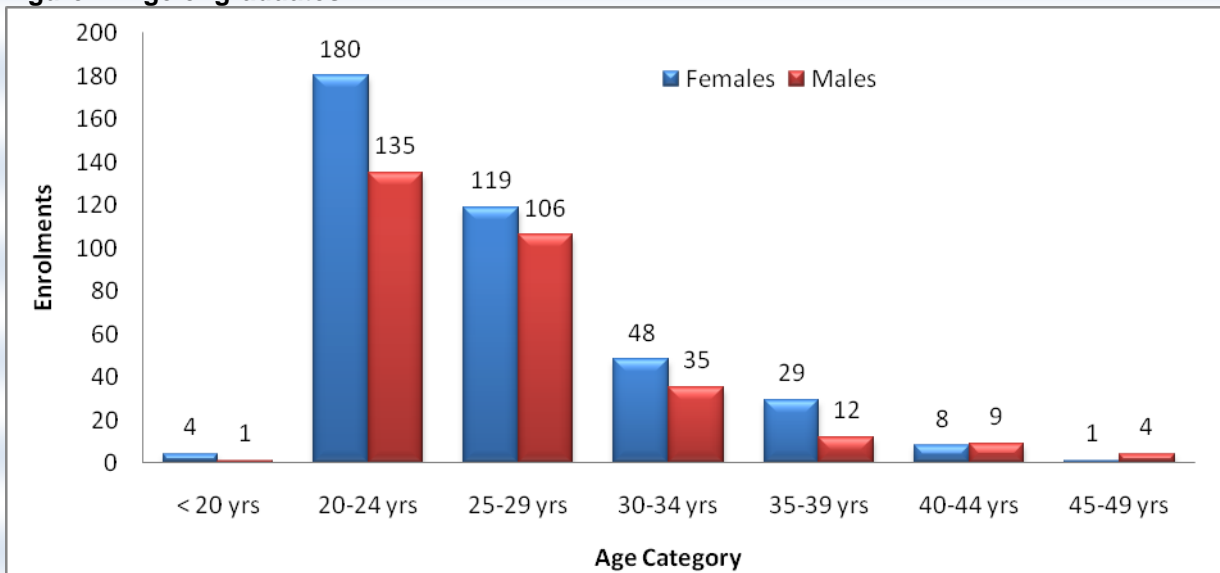


Figure 2 shows that most of the students are between the age categories of 20-24 years followed by 25-29 years of age. It was found Most (79%) of the students are below 30 years of age, this may be the factors to more single students than married **see figure 2**.
