# MASTER OF INTEGRATED WATER RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

The water related challenges facing the world and the Southern African region in particular require an integrated water resources management approach. The School of Engineering is introducing a two-year Master's degree in Integrated Water Resources Management (M.IWRM) in the 2011 academic year. This highly structured and coordinated programme aims at enriching local and regional professionals working in the area of water resources management with the required academic and technical/laboratory skills that will on completion enable professionals to broadly design, manage, maintain and operate different water-related systems such as reservoirs, water utilities, ground water resources, trans-boundary and shared water courses.

## Requirements

The Master of Integrated Water Resources Management seeks to recruit suitably qualified students who are capable of benefitting from, contributing to, and successfully completing the programme. The admission requirements for the programme are as follows:

- A relevant Bachelor's degree from a recognised institution, or an equivalent qualification at NQF Level 8, that shall include a component of independent research or a recognised graduate degree with a research component.
- A minimum of two years' work experience.
- Any other equivalent qualifications and experience as agreed by the Senate.

## Mode of delivery

The programme is using a modular block learning method, which will mean:

- courses will be delivered as modules (taught in blocks) at the Polytechnic of Namibia, Windhoek, during specific periods of the year. This may include weekends and holidays. This will allow students to follow the courses while they are employed.

## Duration

The duration for Master of Integrated Water Resources Management programme will be a minimum of two years and a maximum of four years.
