

# NOTICE

## Fees for the 2010 Academic Year

The Council of the Polytechnic of Namibia at its meeting of 11 September 2009 resolved to increase tuition and other fees for the 2010 academic year, as follows:

1. Tuition: 8%
2. Accommodation – international students: 10%
3. Meals: 5%
4. Other fees: 10%

The increases stem mainly from the need to maintain institutional quality and service standards in the face of inflationary pressure. Expenses that are particularly vulnerable to cost increases include items such as equipment (e.g. computers and video projectors), consumables such as stationery and laboratory materials, utilities such as electricity charges and faculty and staff salaries.
